THAT, Justin Hanson, Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Program, requesting Grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$5,000,000, for a new Police Station Safe Room Project; and

THAT, the City of Covington will be responsible for the local cash/match to be provided in full by the Police Station account; and

THAT, Justin Hanson, Mayor, be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer, and to perform on behalf of the City of Covington, Tennessee, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
