Jason

Here is an update on the gasifier situation that I hope you will share with Mayor Hensley and Attorney Witherington The company that visited the site on March 28 and the other plasma arc manufacturing company that was conducting due diligence on the project have both rejected the opportunity. As a result there is a buyer with financing available. That would be my company.

Our bank and our management has reached the conclusion that there are a few alternatives for the equipment. The first is to maintain its current location and secure new permits from TDEC and followed by a purchase of the unit for the outstanding bond obligation

The second is to follow the permit process but negotiate an assumption of the bond obligation with continued monthly payments to the bond holders in excess of \$11,000 per month. The third alternative is to buy the unit and relocate it to either a site in Mississippi or in Alabama. Under such circumstances, we would conclude a purchase now and then secure permits in one of the new locations. However, the cost of dismantling and relocating the system will exceed \$500,000 As a result the acquisition price of the system would be less than the current outstanding bond obligation.

The situation has been analyzed with the help of the original equipment designer, the state regulatory agencies in all three states that could house the unit and the bank capable of doing the financing. Of course, such opinions are just that--opinions and the only one that really counts is the city's.

The same technology, although with a much greater daily treatment capacity (over 70 tons per day) is being re-permitted for
