### GENERAL SUMMARY:

- Responsible for routine public contact and safety work and serving as a pool lifeguard. Perform work in the operation and maintenance of the swimming pool. Teach Swimming Lessons

### MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

#### •Education and Experience:

- (A) Certified in American Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid and CPR/AED for the Lifeguard.
- (B) American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification required.
- (C) Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations. Good decision-maker. Excellent communication skills, both verbally and in writing.
- (D) Must be at least 17 years old.

### SALARY:

- Grade Level 2: \$11.00 per hour

### Work Hours and Work Days:

- approx..32 hours per week. Must be available to work at the pool from the hours of 10:00am until 10:30pm. Monday through Sunday.

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Monitor activities, provide instructions and prevent accidents in the aquatics facility.

Respond appropriately to swimmers in danger of drowning and to all illness and injury accidents around the entire aquatics facility immediately and appropriately. This includes, but is not limited to performing Lifeguarding skills, First Aid, CPR, and other until arrival of emergency medical services.

Maintain the pool system including chemical readings, balancing and filtration.

Set up and clean up the facility daily.

Operate and clean the concession stand.

Enforce all aquatics facility rules, policies, and procedures.

Assist with the training of lifeguards.

### WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee works in outside weather conditions. The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, toxic or caustic chemicals.
