LOCAL SMOKE APPLICATION

This year, Covington World's Oldest BBQ Cooking Contest will add a new area for people interested in having a place of their own, but don't want to enter the cooking competition. This area will be known as "Local Smoke".

Local Smoke is for anyone who would like to put up a tent to cook and/or have a place for their friends and family to call "home" during the Friday night festivities of the BBQ Fest. Local Smoke area will be in the grassy area just outside the equestrian arena that overlooks the BBQ Fest. Participants in Local Smoke will be allowed to put up their tent beginning Friday morning, May 31, at 8 am. All tents must be staked down. If you plan to cook in your assigned area, you will need a fire extinguisher that is in good condition and properly tagged.

The fee for a 10 x 10 spot at Local Smoke will be \$25. Space here is very limited with no water hook-up and very limited access to electricity. All 10 x 10 areas will be on a first come, first serve basis. (Date application and fees are received.)
