EAGLE SCOUT PROJECTS – GAGA BALL PIT

GaGa Ball Pit Rules

- All players start with one hand touching a wall of the pit.
- The game begins with a referee throwing the ball into the center of the pit.
- When the ball enters the pit, the players scream 'GA' for the first two bounces, and 'GO' on the third bounce, after which the ball is in action.
- Once the ball is in play, any player can hit the ball with an open or closed hand.
- If a ball touches a player below the knee (even if the player hits himself or herself) he or she is out and leaves the pit. If a player is hit above the knees, the play continues.
- If a ball is caught on a fly, the player who hit the ball is out.
- If the ball goes out of the Ga-ga pit the last player to touch the ball is eliminated.
- Using the walls of the octagon to aid in jumping is legal as long as the player does not permanently sit on the ledge of the octagon.
- Players cannot hold the ball.

If needed, a second ball can be thrown in the pit to expedite the end of the game. The last player standing is the winner of that round.







Flight Check verification report
Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPI)
Covington Municipal Airport - Covington Tennessee

Summary:

The new PAPI units on both runways 1 and 19 were adjusted to nominal angles and the FAA flight check series was completed successfully on December 4, 2019 via aircraft N78.

The commissioned glide angles are as follows:

Runway 1 3.13 degrees
Runway 19 3.11 degrees

All other checked parameters were within FAA tolerances.

The tables below should be kept for reference. Note that they will likely be some small percentage away from this actual number at times. As long as the unit is not in tilt failure they are fine. All of these angles were saved in the projector memory as nominal values. The units are decimal degrees, and correspond to the unit displays.

The final angles for each projector in the PAPI array are as follows (A is farthest from the runway centerline):
