Finance and Administration Committee Meeting - 9/20/21



Present: Chairman CH Sullivan, Mayor Justin Hanson, Aldermen/woman Danny Wallace, Chris Richardson, Johnetta Yarbrough, Jeff Morris. Recorder Treasurer Tina Dunn, Directors Lessie Fisher and David Gray, Asst. Chief Jeremy Channell, Lt. Tony Ginn

Alderman Sullivan presented requests to waive fees that were received at the Special Events Committee Meeting. MVP Elite and Go Lucy Go have requested the city waive fees associated with their upcoming events. Both organizations are non-profit. MVP Elite has requested the timing fee for the event be waived. Go Lucy Go has requested the public safety and public work fees be waived.

Motion was made by Alderman Wallace and seconded by Alderwoman Yarbrough to waive fees for MVP Elite contingent on them providing proof of non-profit status. Motion passed.

Motion was made by Alderman Wallace and seconded by Alderman Richardson to waive fees for Go Lucy Go event. Motion passed.

Alderman Sullivan presented contracts from A2H for consulting services and the Invest Prep Grant for approval. Motion was made by Alderman Sullivan and seconded by Alderman Morris to approve the contract from A2H for on call city consulting services for 2021-2024. This will be sent to the Board for approval. Motion passed.

Motion made by Alderman Morris and seconded by Alderman Richardson to approve the contract from A2H for their professional services on the 2021 Invest Prep Grant and send to Board for approval. Motion passed.

Lt. Ginn requested amendment to the budget to include the purchase of police vehicles. Two vehicles were deemed a total loss. Insurance proceeds for both vehicles total \$33,027. He requested an additional \$37,423 to replace the two vehicles. Motion was made by Alderman Sullivan and seconded by Alderman Richardson to amend the budget to include an additional \$40,000 for the purchase of two police vehicles. Motion passed.

Director Fisher reported discussion on the updates for the code chapters will continue at the next Finance and Administration Committee Meeting.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned.


