

Finance and Administration Committee Meeting – 12/15/20

Charter / Code Update – City Attorney Rachel Witherington

Atty Witherington provided a redline version of the new Charter.

- Discussed the suggestion to define certain terms such as "Officer", "Department Heads", "Employees"
- Discussed other changes in Charter
- Vice Mayor section 23, gives Vice Mayor first priority to fill in for Mayor temporarily or permanently. Has the option to decline. The Board can choose another Alderman or Department Head.
- Discussed filling void for Aldermen seat
- Changed ouster provision for any elected official, written how it is written in State law
- There needs to be a resolution for the next Board meeting to move forward with changes
- Motion made to send Charter as presented to full Board, 2nd, discussion, Attorney Witherington discussed other sections including City court, Alderman Edwards discussed Mayor and Board voting, motion passes

City Property Discussion – Mayor Justin Hanson, Director Tiny Rose

- Chairman Sullivan discussed listing and sale of properties
- Mayor Hanson discussed Mark Herbison's work on selling Anderson property
- Attorney Witherington discussed appraisal on old police station property (Pleasant), easement, parking, etc. Will make sure everyone has a copy
- The Board will vote to list property after Covington Reality submits agreement

Salary Study Discussion – Police Chief Larry Lindsey

- Chief Lindsey conducted workforce study, results would justify the amount of officers we have and pay increase requested
- Discussion about state of the department, hiring, training, and investment costs in certified vs. non-certified officers
- Motion made to approve Chief Lindsey's request for pay increase, 2nd, discussion, Tina Dunn requested January 30th start date, Chairman Sullivan amended to reflect, motion passes.

There being no further business, meeting is adjourned.
