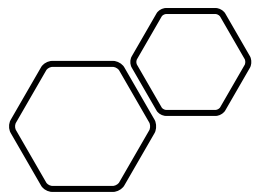

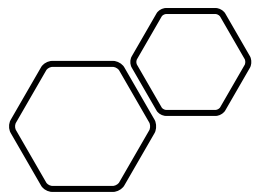

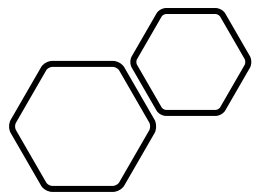
Volleyball starts November 12th.

Bids for Crowning of the fields and the storage building will be opened November 18th.

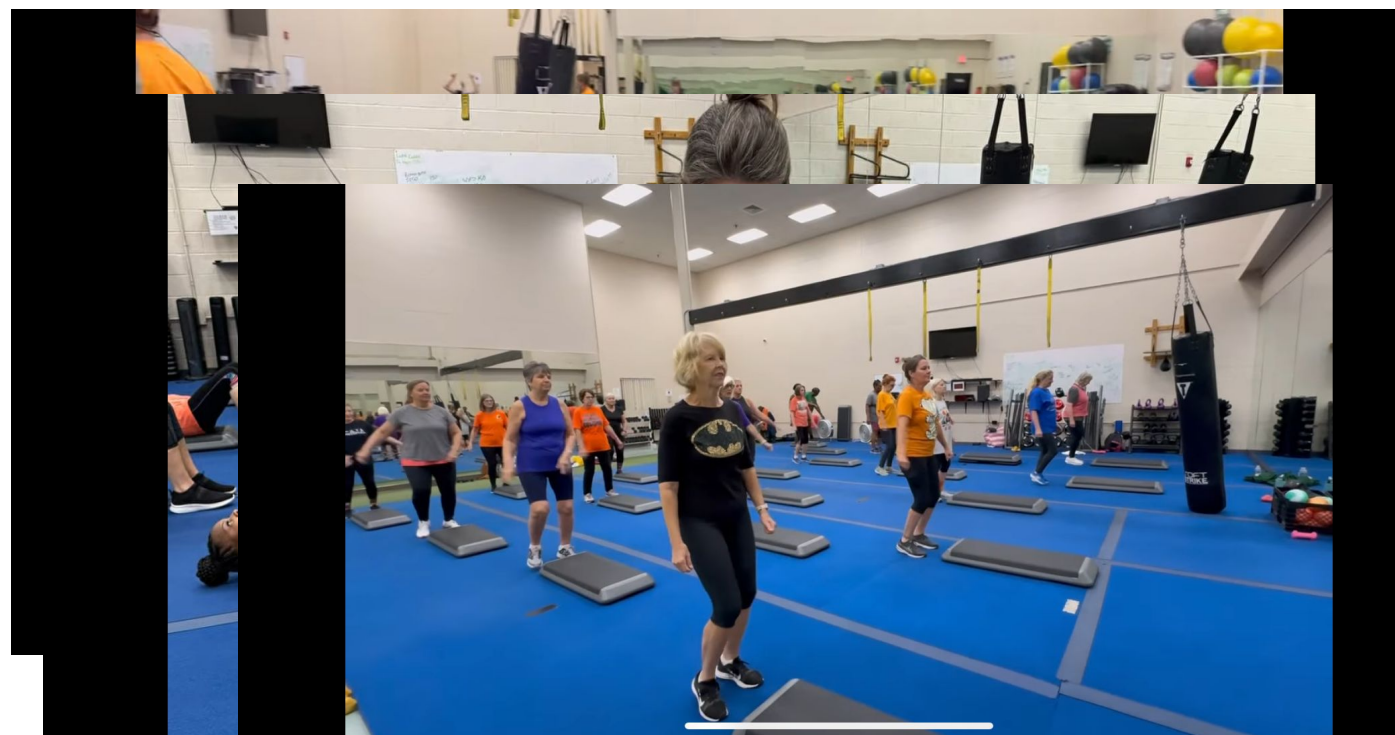
